TUITION CHARGES

The tuition fee is billed in two installments: 60% due on July 1 and 40% due on January 15. A late fee of \$250.00 will be applied if payment is not received within 15 days of due date. Several tuition payment plans are available through Tuition Management Systems. Information is available through the Business Office or on our website. No rebate, allowance or deduction will be made for late entrance, withdrawal, dismissal, or absence due to illness or accident for this or any school year. Tuition Refund Plan insurance is available to protect the family's financial obligation in the event of separation or accident. A \$500.00 enrollment deposit is due by February 15 and is not refundable. The \$500.00 deposit will be credited to the first semester tuition.
